Insured adults will no longer be eligible to receive low cost, federally subsidized vaccines. This holds true for patients with high deductibles and co-pays, as well as patients with Medi-Cal and PHC. Immunizations can be purchased.

Some vaccines are available at a reduced price for adults who qualify. Please check with the clinic staff for eligibility requirements.
